



The Evolution of Gully Features in Acidalia Planitia

These gullies occur exclusively on the northern wall of a crater. This is unlike most of the observed gully sites in the northern Martian hemisphere, which typically have gullies on their pole-facing slopes. Another unique observation of this set of gullies is that they start mid-way down the crater's wall rather than cutting directly into the upper crater wall or rim.
