

Bedrock Exposed in the Rim of Hale Crater

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Hale Crater is a large impact crater (more than 100 kilometers) with a suite of interesting features such as active gullies, active recurring slope lineae, and extensive icy ejecta flows. There are also exposed diverse (colorful) bedrock units, such as in this cutout. (256 km above the surface, less than 1 km across).
