



Opportunity Rover Tracks at Victoria Crater

Acquisition date: 26 June 2007 Approximately 273 kilometers above the surface

The rover's tracks are visible as faint parallel lines punctuated by dots where the rover stopped to perform scientific investigations or turned for course corrections or to facilitate communications. The oldest tracks date from September 2006, and extend from the upper left corner of the image to an embayment called Duck Bay.
