

## RSL and Colorful Fans along Coprates Chasma Ridge

This site along a Coprates Chasma ridge shows what we call recurring slope lineae (or RSL) on generally north-facing slopes in northern summer/southern winter. All of the lineae here and in the larger scene appear to originate from relatively bright bedrock outcrops. Some of the fans that RSL flow over became darker and brighter over time.
