

Layers and Fractures in Ophir Chasma

This image features a small part of its wall and floor. The wall rock shows many sedimentary layers and the floor is covered with windblown ridges, which are intermediate in size between sand ripples and sand dunes. Rocks protruding on the floor could be volcanic intrusions of once-molten magma that have pushed aside the surrounding sedimentary layers and "frozen" in place.



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
