

A Sneak Peek into Saheki's Secret Layers

Saheki Crater is large, about 84 kilometers across, and located in the Southern highlands of Mars, to the north of Hellas Planitia. Exposed along the crater's interior walls [link to subframe image], we can see that the fan is made up of multiple individual layers (white and purple tones in the enhanced color image) that were deposited on the floor.
