This observation of a complex crater in Terra Cimmeria has a lot to show: exposed bedrock, pitted material, collapsed rims that formed terraces and even dark-toned material that was excavated during the impact. It's a geological treat! (NASA/JPL/University of Arizona. 255 km above the surface, less than 5 km across.)
