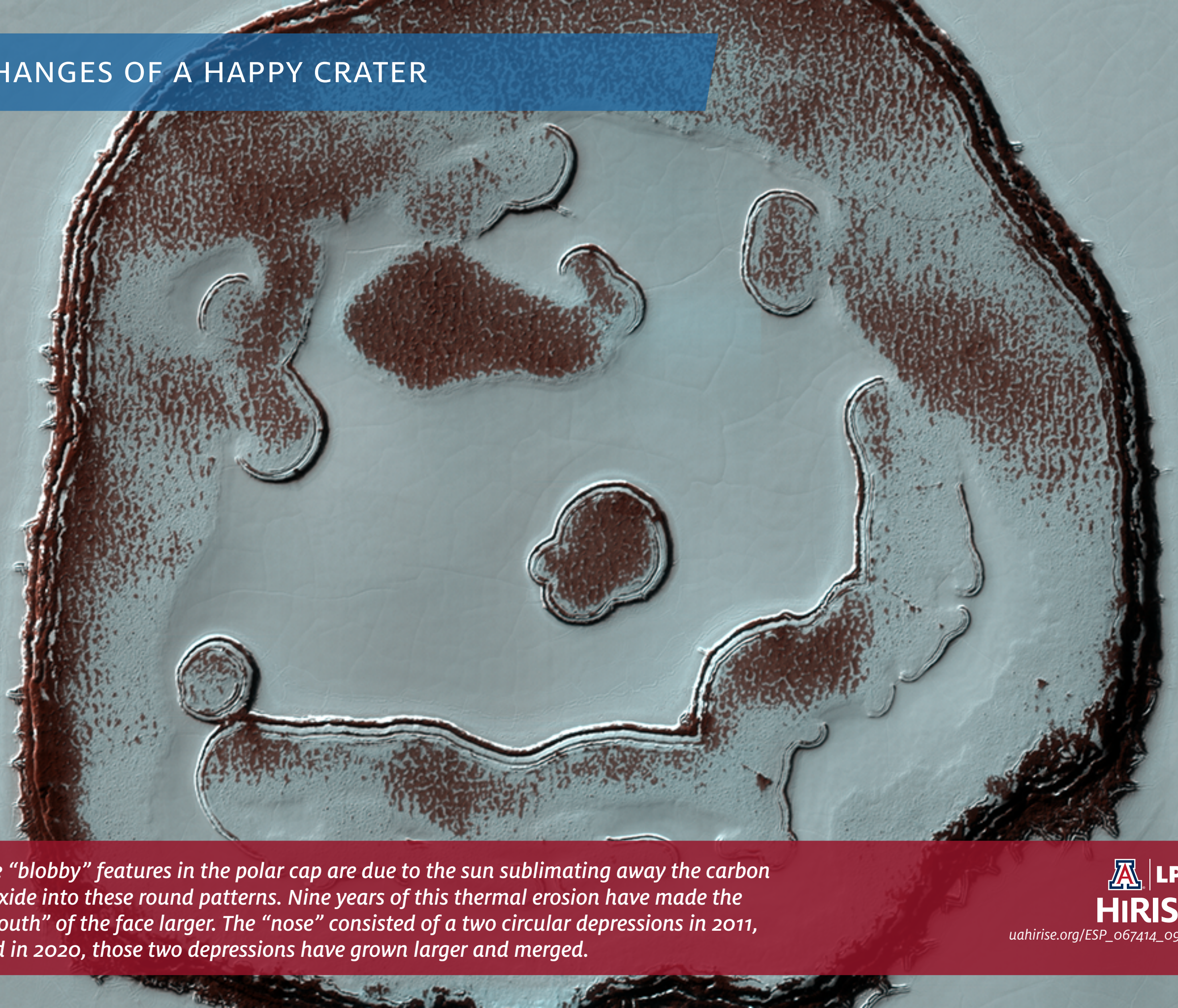


CHANGES OF A HAPPY CRATER



The “blobby” features in the polar cap are due to the sun sublimating away the carbon dioxide into these round patterns. Nine years of this thermal erosion have made the “mouth” of the face larger. The “nose” consisted of a two circular depressions in 2011, and in 2020, those two depressions have grown larger and merged.
