



A DIVERSITY OF DUNES IN RENAUDOT CRATER

Renaudot is a 64-kilometers diameter impact crater located on the border of Utopia and Terra Sabaea, Mars. It contains a variety of dunes that vary in size, shape, and composition. Both dark and light-toned dunes are located on the floor of this crater. The dark-toned dunes are likely basaltic sand while the light-toned dunes source from other materials.



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
