



## Layered History

The geologic history of a planet is written in its layers. Erosion of the surface reveals several shades of light-toned layers, likely sedimentary deposits. The most recent geologic features are the narrow sand dunes snaking across the top of all the rock. (NASA/JPL/University of Arizona: less than 1 km across.)
