



A New Impact Site in the Southern Middle Latitudes

Over 500 new impact events have been detected from before-and-after images, mostly from MRO's Context Camera, with a HiRISE followup. This new impact, which occurred between August and December 2016, would provide an important constraint if ice was detected, but alas, none was actually exposed.
