



Lingering Frost

The North Polar layered deposits comprise a thick stack of icy layers. Part of this image has lingering seasonal frost, which serves to accentuate those layers. An additional rationale for this observation is to document new activity in scarp erosion. NASA/JPL/University of Arizona (319 km above the surface, less than 1 km across.)
