



## RING-SHAPED MOUNDS IN CERAUNIUS

Ceraunius Fossae is well-known for having thousands of normal faults. Winding channels thought to have formed by streams are also common in this area. What is surprising is the group of ring-shaped mounds. How these landforms develop is somewhat of a mystery, and they may be related to steam explosions below active lava flows or eruptions of mud from deep underground.



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
