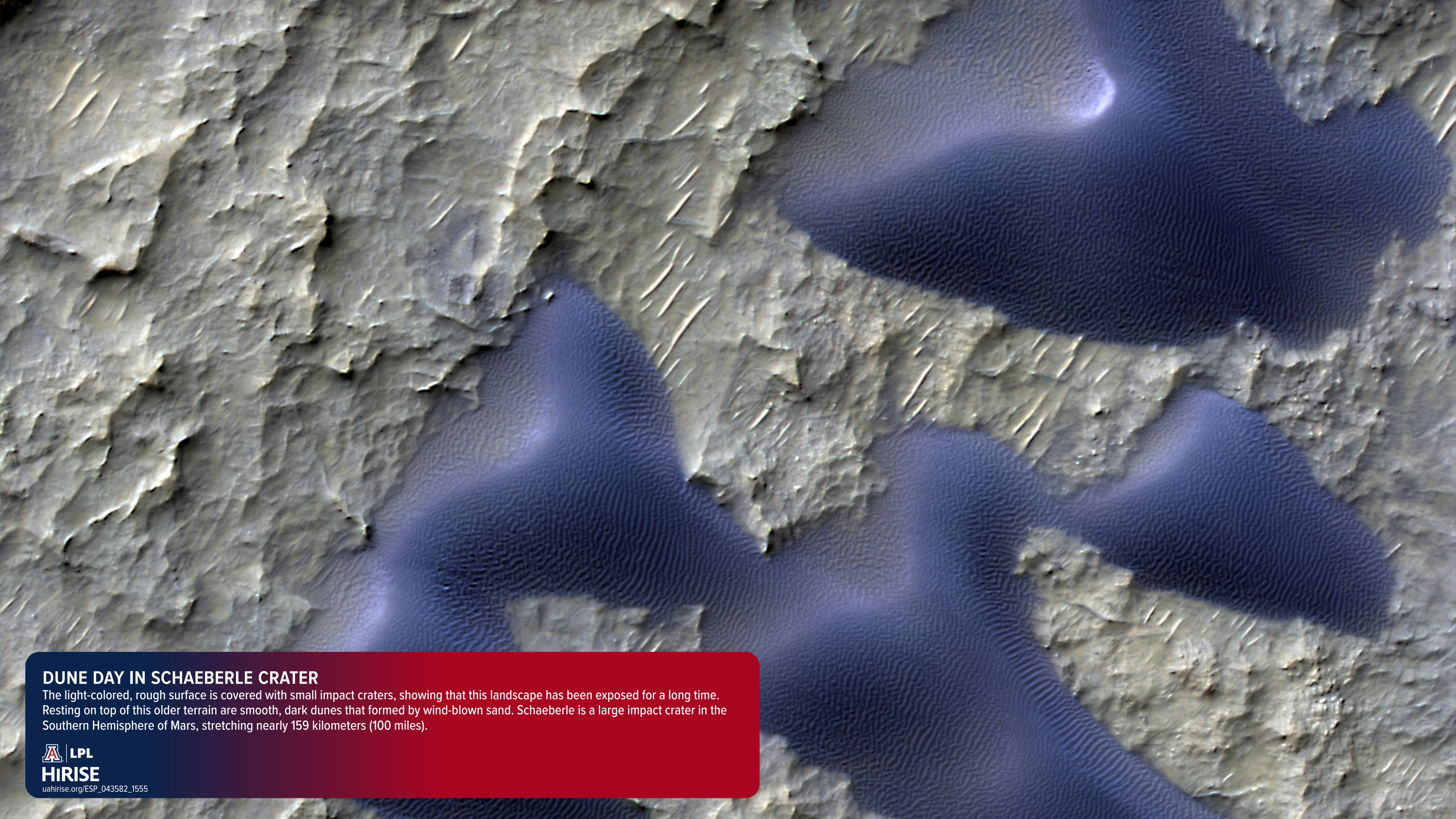




DUNE DAY IN SCHAEBERLE CRATER

The light-colored, rough surface is covered with small impact craters, showing that this landscape has been exposed for a long time. Resting on top of this older terrain are smooth, dark dunes that formed by wind-blown sand. Schaeberle is a large impact crater in the Southern Hemisphere of Mars, stretching nearly 159 kilometers (100 miles).



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
