



Megabreccia on the Floor of an Impact Crater

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“Megabreccia” is a term we use to describe jumbled, fragmented blocks of rock larger than 1 meter across, in a matrix of finer-grained materials. It’s the result of energetic processes, typically from an impact event. This image was acquired by HiRISE only in the narrow color strip, as a “ridealong” with a CRISM target, since HiRISE had previously imaged this location.
