This image covers Luki Crater in the Southern highlands. This crater formed on the floor of Uzboi Vallis between Hale and Holden craters, near the confluence with Nanedi Vallis. The central region of the crater consists of uplifted ancient bedrock with a great variety of rock types, as shown by the color diversity.

The HIRISE camera onboard the Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter is the most powerful one of its kind ever sent to another planet. Its high resolution allows us to see Mars like never before, and helps other missions choose a safe spot to land for future exploration.
