



Touring a Dusty Region

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As well as confirming a new impact, this image also showed other features commonly found in dusty areas: slope streaks and bed-forms. This close-up of the roughly 2.5 km-diameter crater at the bottom of the main image shows ridges on the crater floor where dust has become trapped within the crater, and bright and dark streaks down the crater walls where dust has avalanched down the slope.
