



Craters within Craters

Sandwiched between a larger crater—one nearly 4 kilometer across—at the north and the southern edge of a much larger crater—one over 15-kilometers and certainly older--is this small impact crater that’s exposed light-toned material in its ejecta. Because the material is still brighter than the surrounding surface, darker dust settling out of the atmosphere has not had time to cover it up, so the crater is fairly recent.
