

A Dark-Toned, Pitted Mound in a Crater in Northeast Arabia Terra

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This fascinating observation shows us a dark-toned mound with pits inside an impact crater. Are these pits the result of sublimation? The crater itself is an ancient one, as evidenced by the eroded rim. For the mound inside, HiRISE resolution can give us a closer look at textural features that might help explain what we're looking at: layers in pit walls, or perhaps cracks from expansion?
