This HiRISE image captures a new, dated impact crater that triggered a slope streak. Slope streaks are created when dry dust avalanches leave behind dark swaths on dusty Martian hills. The faded scar of an old avalanche can also be seen just to the side of the new dark streak. (276 km above the surface, less than 1 km across.)
