



Rising Above It in Amazonis Planitia

The feature resembles a plateau. Dark streaks mark steep slopes on its sides while the top appears flat. The slope streaks are not all the same age, as we see a variation in colors from faint to dark. Craters in a variety of sizes and ages pepper the entire rectangle, but the dark, textured floor has very few noticeable craters. (NASA/JPL/University of Arizona: 287 km above the surface, less than 5 km across.)
