

In the Gullies and Bedrock of Ius Chasma

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We see a portion of a steep slope with gullies extending downhill. Many of the gully floors are dark, and in some places that dark material extends onto the fan-shaped deposits of the gullies. These dark features are candidates for recurring slope lineae, which are seasonal features that grow incrementally. What is their relationship to the gullies? (NASA/JPL/University of Arizona, less than 1 km across.)
