The HiRISE camera has done it again: here is yet another stunning image of an active dust devil on Mars. The dust devil is bright, and its core is roughly 50 meters across. The dark streak on the ground behind the dust devil is its shadow. The length of the shadow suggests the plume of rotating dust rises about 650 meters into the atmosphere! (NASA/JPL/UArizona)
