

A GECKO-SHAPED FISSURE VENT IN GORDII FOSSAE



Gordii Fossae is a volcanic region near Olympus Mons, the planet's largest volcano. The smooth volcanic surfaces in the Gordii Fossae region are sometimes interrupted by long, narrow troughs, or fissures. If you use your imagination, this trough resembles a gecko with its long tail and web-shaped feet!

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
